3. Eligibility & Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the International Optimist Dinghy Class (Including plastic hulls and prams), Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Club 420

3.2 This is a beginner's regatta; Opti Gold Fleet will be for Red, White, Blue, and Experienced Green Fleet (1.5yrs+), Opti Silver Fleet will be for beginner Green fleet sailors.

3.3 Eligible youth may be entered by registering through Regatta Network

Scoring will also be added to the Treasure Coast Opti Regatta Series for those participating.

All competitors shall wear U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets at all times while on the water.
