## ASA 101 BASIC KEELBOAT SAILING

---

**Prerequisites:** None

**Description:** Sailors will learn to skipper & crew a sloop-rigged sailboat of approximately 20-27 feet in length by day in light to moderate winds and sea conditions. Knowledge of basic sailing terminology, parts and functions, helm commands, basic sail trim, points of sail, buoyage, seamanship and safety including navigation rules to avoid collisions and hazards will be taught.

**Length:** 24 hours (3 or 4 days)

**Scheduling:** 3 Saturdays, 3 Sundays, or Week-days. Private scheduling is also available.

**Course Size:** Maximum 4 sailors

Private: Minimum 2 sailors

**Fee:** Course \$775/sailor

- Includes: ASA's *Sailing Made Easy*, ASA Log Book, classroom instruction, boat usage fee with instructor, on-the-water training and testing, written test and 1 year of ASA membership.

## ASA 103 BASIC COASTAL CRUISING

---

**Prerequisites:** ASA Membership, 101 Certification

**Description:** Sailors will learn to skipper & crew a sloop-rigged auxiliary powered (inboard or outboard engine) keelboat of approximately 25 to 35 feet in length by day in moderate winds (up to 20 knots) and sea conditions. Knowledge of cruising sailboat terminology, basic boat systems, auxiliary engine operation, docking procedures, intermediate sail trim, navigation rules, basic coastal navigation, anchoring, weather interpretation, safety and seamanship will be taught.

**Length:** 24 hours (3 or 4 days)

**Scheduling:** 3 Saturdays, 3 Sundays, or Weekdays. Private scheduling is also available.

**Course Size:** Maximum 4 sailors

Private: Minimum 2 sailors

**Fee:** Course \$725/sailor

- Includes: ASA's *Coastal Cruising Made Easy*, classroom instruction, boat usage fee with instructor, on-the-water training and testing, written test.
